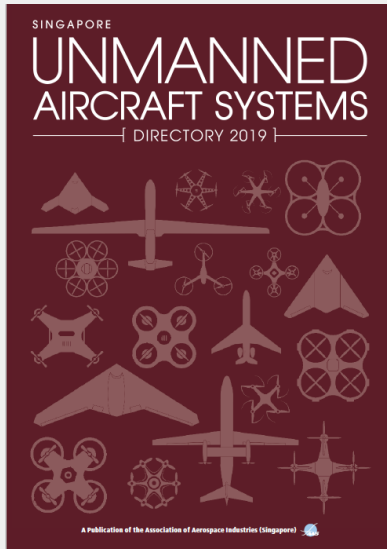


SAESL Crowned Champions of Futsal Tournament
