Economic Strategies for Recovery

Deputy Prime Minister, Coordinating Minister for Economic Policies and Minister for Finance Heng Swee Keat delivered a Ministerial Statement on 5 Oct 2020. DPM provided an update on the overall response to COVID-19 and outlined a three-pronged approach to a refreshed economic strategy with strong emphases on resilience, sustainability, and inclusive growth.

Measures to provide continued support for workers, jobs and firms, were also outlined. Salient highlights are:

- The Enhanced Training Support Package for Aerospace unveiled last month, will be extended another 6 months till 30 Jun 2021.
- As previously announced, the enhanced Jobs Support Scheme for Aerospace has been extended at 50% support until 31 Mar 2021.
- For those with capacity to hire, the Government will co-fund the first \$5,000 of gross monthly wages for new local hires up to 12 months.
- Capability-building grants for businesses seeking to internationalise, transform, and digitalise will be extended or enhanced.

The following day, Minister for Transport Ong Ye Kung made a Ministerial Statement, outlining steps to support the recovery of the Air Hub, connectivity and airlines. Click on the buttons below to view the full statements.

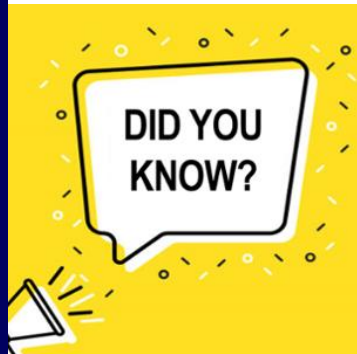
Certified Quality Engineer for Aerospace (CQEA)
