## Vaccination-differentiated SMMs

Since 10 August 2021, a person is considered to be “vaccinated” and eligible for vaccination-differentiated Safe Management Measures (SMM) if he or she has:

- a) Been fully vaccinated, i.e.
  - has received the full regimen of Pfizer-BioNTech/Comirnaty, Moderna with an additional two weeks for the vaccine to be fully effective; or
  - received the full regimen of World Health Organisation Emergency Use Listing (WHO EUL) vaccines (e.g. AstraZeneca-SKBio, Serum Institute of India, Jassen, Sinopharm, Sinovac-CoronaVac) including their respective duration post-vaccination for the vaccine to be fully effective; or

b) Recovered from COVID-19, i.e. less than 270 days of first positive PCR test result obtained in Singapore; or

c) Recovered from COVID-19 and has taken one dose of Pfizer-BioNTech/Comirnaty, Moderna, with an additional two weeks for the vaccine to be fully effective; or

d) Obtained a negative result on a pre-event test by a MOH-approved COVID-19 Test Provider in the past 24 hours, covering the duration of the stipulated activity; or

Children who are 12 years old and below are currently ineligible for vaccines under the National Vaccination Programme. These children are eligible for vaccination-differentiated SMMs.


