Advisory on work & leave arrangement for employees who test ART-positive but are physically well

The tripartite partners have issued an advisory to provide guidance to employers and employees, who test positive on the Antigen Rapid Test (ART) but are physically well, regarding work and leave arrangements.

Self-isolation approach for ART-positive employees

Employees who are ART-positive but physically well are advised to self-isolate at home for 72 hours. After 72 hours, the employee should repeat the ART.

- If the result is negative, the employee may return to work and daily activities.
- + If the result is positive, the employee should continue to self-isolate and take another ART every 24 hours until a negative ART result is received.

Work and leave arrangements for ART-positive but physically well employees under self-isolation

- ✓ Employees should immediately inform their employer and begin self-isolation at home.
- ✗ Employers should not ask these employees to report to the workplace.
- ✓ Employees should be allowed to work from home if they are able to do so. If working from home is not possible, employers should treat the period of absence as paid sick leave.
