Industry Performance Data by EDB and MTI

MTI and EDB have recently released the **Economic Survey of Singapore Third Quarter 2021** and the **Monthly Manufacturing Performance October 2021** respectively.

In 3Q2021, the Singapore economy grew by 7.1% year-on-year basis, slower than the 15.2% expansion recorded in 2Q2021. The GDP growth forecast for Singapore is "around 7.0%" in 2021 and "3.0 to 5.0%" in 2022.

Singapore's manufacturing output increased 16.9% in October 2021. **The aerospace segment grew 26.9%** "as demand for maintenance, repair and overhaul activities improved compared to a year ago, when there was widespread grounding of aircraft due to COVID-19 international travel restrictions."

Innovation in the Air Transport Industry

Co-organised with Starburst Aerospace, this webinar held on 11 November 2021 provided updates on the Singapore Aviation Accelerator which had graduated 8 start-ups from its inaugural cohort and is working with them on commercialization. A highlight of the webinar was the presentation by Mr Paul Brady of CarbonClick which has developed a carbon offset solution for airports, airlines, and e-commerce platforms. This was followed by a panel discussion with Mr Karthikeyan T. of SIA Engineering Company and Mr Alex Kasinec of Evitado Technologies (a start-up that is working on a ground collision avoidance solution with SIAEC).



Transformation & Opportunities in the Aerospace sector



The event was moderated by CE AAIS and featured a panel discussion with Mr Hanaka Minoru (GM International Affairs, Society of Japanese Aerospace Companies) and Mr Naguib Mohd Nor (President, Malaysia Aerospace Industry Association), The panel shared its view of the pandemic's impact on industry, and the role of industry associations and technology in recovery. This was followed by a presentation by Mr Shawn Lee (Head of Digital Solutions APAC, Airbus Group) on the progress of Airbus' Skywise digital service and its impact on customers.
