Aerospace Community Project: Bringing Chinese New Year Cheer to the Elderly

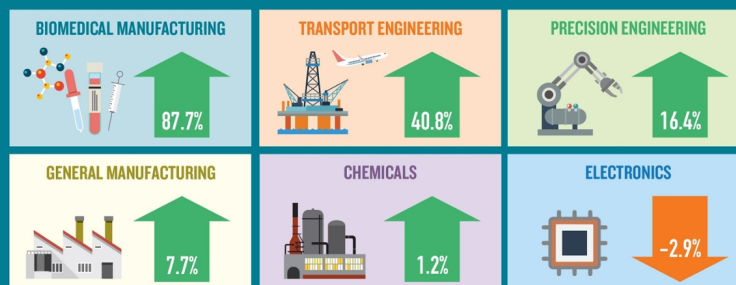

Industry Performance in December 2021, and Business Expectations for the Next 3, 6 months

All clusters except the electronics cluster recorded output growth.

The aerospace segment grew **58.9% in December 2021** compared to the same period in 2020, according to the December Manufacturing Performance report by EDB. The growth in output was attributed to higher demand for maintenance, repair and overhaul activities, due to the easing of global travel restrictions compared to the previous year. **For the whole of 2021, the aerospace cluster grew 8.8%** compared to 2020.

Overall, business sentiments in the manufacturing sector remain positive despite the uncertainties caused by the COVID-19 variants and pressures on supply chains. The aerospace sector is one of the most optimistic, with a net weighted balance of **76% of firms anticipating a favourable business situation in the first half of 2022**, compared to the fourth quarter of 2021. A net weighted balance of **61% of aerospace firms also project a higher level of production in the first quarter of 2022**, compared to the previous quarter, as more aircraft engine repair work from commercial airlines is expected.
