Highlights

Singapore Sustainable Air Hub Blueprint

Singapore has set its sights on developing the above Blueprint, even as the aviation sector revives and we rebuild the Singapore air hub. An International Advisory Panel has been formed to engage industry stakeholders to canvas ideas and develop practical pathways to greener air travel. In tandem with this, initial steps are being taken to build a sustainable air hub:

- For a one-year period starting from the third quarter of this year, all SIA and Scoot flights out of Changi Airport will use a blend of refined jet fuel and neat Sustainable Aviation Fuel.
- Various initiatives are also being taken at Singapore Changi Airport, such as the installation of solar panels, electrification of ground fleet, implementation of energy-efficient systems and the use of more renewable energy.
- Efforts are underway to tap new technologies and international collaboration to improve air traffic management efficiency, thus reducing airborne time and fuel use.


