Dialogue with EASA Executive Director, Mr Patrick Ky

AAIS was honoured to co-organise this dialogue session with the EASA regional office on 18 May 2022 at the Swissotel Stamford Hotel.

The session began with a welcome by Mr David Waller, EASA representative in Singapore, and was moderated by Mr Wong Yue Jeen, AAIS President. Mr Patrick Ky made a short presentation touching on key topics including innovation, urban air mobility artificial intelligence, and underlined the aviation industry's focus on sustainability and a "Green Recovery". He also gamely took on questions from senior executives and industry leaders in attendance, covering manpower crunch issues and geopolitical challenges in Europe impacting aviation globally.

Passenger traffic above 40% of pre-Covid levels in May, Terminal 5 project to restart

Changi Airport has recorded a strong recovery of passenger traffic with levels reaching above 40% of pre-Covid levels in May, according to a speech by Transport Minister S Iswaran Opening Address at the Changi Aviation Summit 2022 on 17 May. Recovery is expected to gain momentum with countries like Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand, Vietnam, and South Korea reopening borders to all fully vaccinated travellers from April, as well as the upcoming school holidays and the start of the summer travel period overseas.

Air Traffic statistics by Changi Airport Group recorded 1.93 million passenger movements in April 2022, a more than 10-fold increase from April 2021. Yield-to-date of passenger movements at Changi as at the end of April was 4.5 million passengers, which is close to 50% higher than total passenger movements for the whole of last year. Minister also announced that work on the T5 project will recommence after a comprehensive review of the design to make it more modular and flexible, and enhance its resilience and sustainability.
