Aviation Week Network's MRO Asia-Pacific Awards

Virtual B2B Meetings between Singapore and Malaysia Aerospace Companies



SAQG Workshop: Changes in EASA Part 145





This year, the European Union (EU) and the European Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA)introduced changes to the Part 145 requirements, through Reg. (EU) 2021/700 (applicable since May 2022) and Reg. (EU) 2021/1963 (in force and applicable from 2 December 2022). While only minor changes were introduced to Reg (EU) 2021/700, major and significant changes have been introduced to Reg. (EU) 2021/1963.



The intent of the workshop is to provide the Singapore aerospace industry with relevant updates to facilitate the understanding and the implementation of the abovementioned Part 145 requirements, inclusive of the related AMC/GMs.






