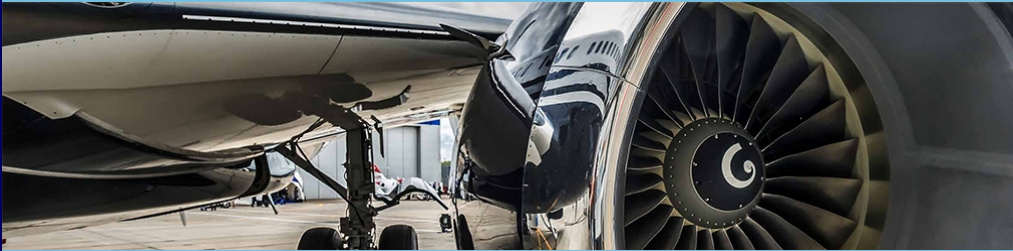

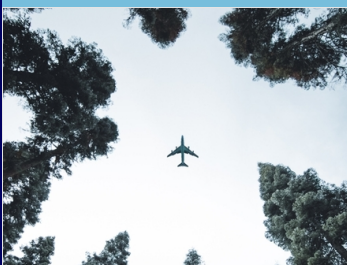
Recent Activities

SAQG Workshop: Changes in EASA Part 145

AAIS held an in-person workshop on the new EASA Part 145 regarding new Safety Management System (SMS) regulations on 4 August 2022, conducted by Mr Luigi Preti, Maintenance Organisation Expert and EASA International Officer in Singapore. The session had a strong turnout, gathering more than 80 aerospace professionals at the AAIS premises in Seletar. Luigi shared useful regulatory updates and highlighted the next steps under the new EASA Part 145. He also shared about the SMS Industry Standard comprising of four major components – safety policy and objectives, safety risk management, safety assurance and safety promotion.
