Highlights

Aerospace Industry Transformation Map (ITM) 2025

Deputy Prime Minister and Coordinating Minister for Economic Policies, Mr Heng Swee Keat launched a series of refreshed Industry Transformation Maps (ITM) on 18 October 2022 for five key sectors, including Aerospace.

The Aerospace ITM 2025 aims to cement Singapore's position as a global node for aerospace manufacturing and Maintenance, Repair, and Overhaul (MRO) activities, with leadership in engine MRO. It also aims to pave the way for participation in future aircraft development programmes through emerging areas. The refreshed ITM, which was shaped with the inputs of industry via the AAIS-EDB Future of Aerospace study in 2021, addresses systemic shifts arising from the COVID-19 pandemic, highlighting key strategies and initiatives to support the industry in recovery and beyond. The main focus areas of ITM 2025 are:

- Building capacity and capability in manufacturing and MRO for new-generation aircraft platforms.
- Driving transformation through technology
- Helping SMEs fly high on the global stage
- Investing in talent
- Gearing up for sustainability and Advanced Air Mobility (AAM)
- Emerging stronger through tripartism and partnerships with Industry Associations

Sunday Cycling Lane at West Camp Road, Seletar

The Land Transport Authority (LTA) has launched an on-road Sunday Cycling Lane (SCL) trial at West Camp Rd road from 16 October 2022. Under the SCL, 1 road lane (per direction) will be dedicated for on-road cyclists every Sunday morning 5am to 11am. The SCL will be demarcated by solid blue lane markings.

During these operating hours, only buses and cyclists are allowed in the cycling lane. Cyclists will not be subject to the limit on group size during these operating hours.

Motorists are advised to filter onto these stretches carefully as cyclists and buses may be using the lane. Please view the brochure for more information.

Industry Preview of Aerospace ITM 2025 by EDB

AAIS was pleased to organise an industry preview of the refreshed Aerospace ITM on 10 October 2022. Held at Seletar Aerospace Park, the preview was attended by representatives from across the industry, government agencies and academia. Mr Abiel Neo, Assistant Vice President, Capital Goods at EDB delivered a comprehensive briefing on the ITM, sharing its target for the aerospace industry to achieve S\$4.6 billion in Value-Added (VA) by 2025, and restoring total employment of the industry to pre-pandemic levels of 22,000 by adding 3,000 jobs.

Following the ITM briefing, participants engaged with a panel consisting of Mr Abiel Neo, Mr Wilin Ng (Chief Commercial Officer at SIA Engineering Company Ltd) and Dr Kenneth Low (AAIS Management Committee Member and Deputy Cluster Director of Singapore Institute of Technology) as moderator. The panel took questions from the audience and had robust discussions on the new strategies, initiatives and shaping the future of the Singapore aerospace industry. Participants also heard from AAIS President Mr Wong Yue Jeen, who shared on the role of the Association in supporting priority areas for members through recovery and beyond.

Aerospace Singapore: InProfile - Simon Wayne, Bombardier



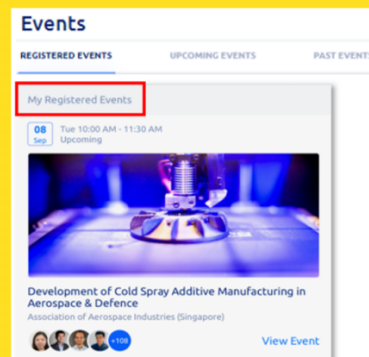
