## Ibaraki Prefecture in Japan Welcoming Synergistic Businesses

The Ibaraki Prefectural Government in Japan is welcoming businesses to set up a presence in the region, particularly in Tsukuba City, the nation's strategic R&D centre. Located only 45 minutes from Tokyo by train and close to Narita International Airport, Tsukuba City houses many of the country's research and educational facilities, including RIKEN, Japan's only comprehensive natural science research institute, and the National Institute of Advanced Industrial Science and Technology (AIST), one of the largest public research institutes in Japan.

Foreign companies investing in Ibaraki Prefecture may be eligible for incentives, including

- Subsidies for the establishment of a business office
- Start-up visa support
- Subsidies for joint research trials
- Support for matching with universities, research institutes, and companies in the prefecture based on the advice of a foreign investment advisor
- Use of low-cost incubation facilities at the Tsukuba Center or Tsukuba Startup Park in central Tsukuba

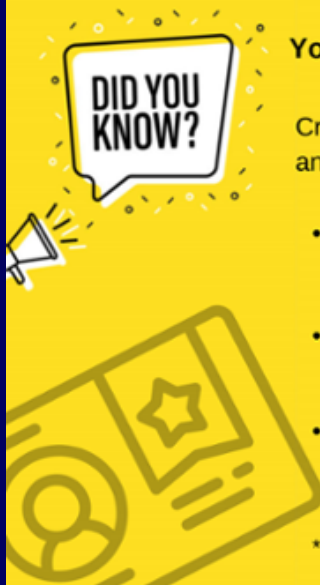
