

Aerospace Industry Output Data: An Encouraging Start

Singapore's aerospace sector grew 26.2% in November 2022 compared to a year ago, with more MRO jobs from commercial airlines on the back of increased global air traffic. According to data from the Singapore Economic Development Board (EDB), the output of the aerospace sector expanded 27.8% on a year-to-date basis. The industry has seen early signs of growth since March 2022, when output exceeded the 2019 level for the first time.

Nevertheless, there are significant risks ahead with heightened global insecurity and a general economic slowdown. Business sentiment for the manufacturing sector, overall, has turned negative. Aerospace, however, is a notable exception with a net weighted balance of 57% of aerospace businesses indicating a positive outlook through to March 2023, according to EDB's business expectations survey.


