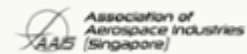

ICAO to form Advanced Air Mobility Study Group (AAM SG)

ICAO is forming an AAM SG to serve as a focal point for ICAO's AAM-related work, with the aim of ensuring global interoperability and harmonization. The AAM SG will perform an assessment of the AAM ecosystem, perform a gap analysis, develop initial guidance material and an outline of a global framework for AAM, as well as develop recommendations for ICAO's future work related to AAM.

The International Coordinating Council of Aerospace Industries Associations (ICCAIA) has been invited to contribute experts to the SG. As a member of ICCAIA we therefore have the opportunity to nominate experts and to participate in the ICCAIA AAM committee(s). It is an opportunity for Singapore-based executives to contribute to the global standardisation/regulatory effort, and to advance industry interests.
