### Unmanned Air Mobility Roundtable

AAIS, ITE and Volocopter were proud to jointly organise the first Urban Air Mobility Roundtable in Singapore on 13 July 2022. Held at ITE College Central, the event brought together UAM professionals and government representatives to discuss the development of the UAM ecosystem and business opportunities in the region. The session kicked off with a welcome by AAIS President as well as insightful presentations and speeches by senior executives from Volocopter and Skyports. This was followed by a robust panel discussion featuring speakers from leading UAM organisations such as Eve Air Mobility, Vertical Aerospace and Volocopter, as well as representatives from CAAS and EDB. Guests also had the chance to visit the VoloCity exhibition for a guided tour.



### Unmanned Aircraft Flying Area

Transport Minister S. Iswaran launched the newly dedicated Unmanned Aircraft Flying Area at Pandan Reservoir on Sunday 17 July 2022. This 16-hectare dedicated flying area provides space for the public to fly their drones, while ensuring public and aviation safety.




This initiative was in response to a recommendation by the UAS Advisory Panel to set up specific drone-friendly areas to increase interest in the hobby.

- \* Post-golf dinner with musical performances, prize giving, CPAS art auction and lucky draw raffle

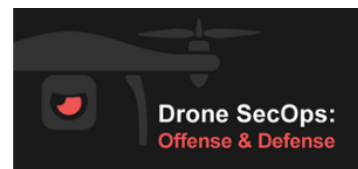
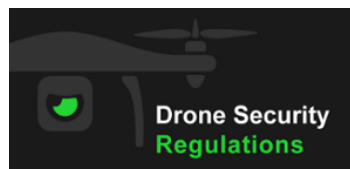
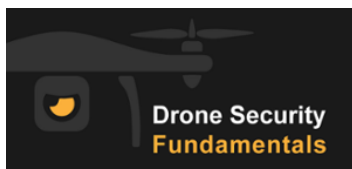
