# **First In-Person Networking Event**



# **Unmanned Aircraft (UA) Registered in Singapore**

Since 20 April 2020, any person who operates an UA with a take-off weight above 250 grams, is required to register with CAAS. The chart below tracks the growing UA registrations over the past 2.5 years, be it for recreational, educational or business purposes.


